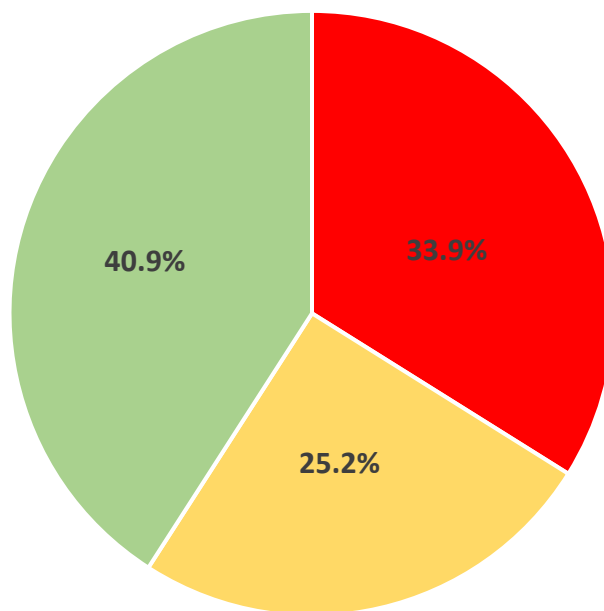

Palm Beach County Radon Test Results by Percentage



- High: > 4.0 pCi/L
- Cautionary: 2.0 to 3.9 pCi/L
- Low: < 1.9 pCi/L



% of test results considered high (4.0 pCi/L or higher).
Fix the building.



% of test results considered cautionary (2.0 – 3.9 pCi/L).
Consider fixing the building.



% of test results considered low (<1.9 pCi/L).
Retest these buildings every 5 years.

Some Details About the Data:

- The dataset includes radon measurements conducted by state-certified Radon Measurement Specialists or Technicians and covers all building levels, not just ground-floor testing.
- Only non-mandatory test results are included, primarily involving residential housing units such as homes, condos, and apartments, though some 24-hour care facilities (such as assisted living or rehabilitation centers) are included if the testing was conducted for non-mandatory reasons. Some commercial building test data is included.
- Mandatory test results for schools, daycares, hospitals and other 24-hours care facilities are excluded. Full details on Florida's mandatory radon testing requirements can be found on the Florida Department of Health website.
- The dataset was filtered to exclude:
 - Results less than 46 hours
 - Post-mitigation tests
 - Results of less than 0.1 pCi/L
 - Multiple results at same location
 - Mandatory test results (schools, daycares, hospitals)
 - Results reported in Working Levels
- The percentage of housing units tested was calculated using housing unit data from the U.S. Census Bureau website [census.gov](https://www.census.gov).

1. Myth Busting: To dispel common misconceptions that suggest there is no or minimal radon in Florida.
2. Education & Awareness: A resource for other radon professionals, residents, realtors, land developers and local officials informing on the radon in their county.
